The mission PBIS/RtI in Milwaukee Public Schools is to provide support to ensure that academic and social emotional needs of *all* students are met.

The vision of PBIS/RtI in Milwaukee Public Schools is for every student to experience school as a place where staff meets them where they are academically and behaviorally to provide them with the tools they need to become productive citizens.

Timeline

2007-2008

- Council of Great City Schools first recommends district-wide implementation of PBIS

2008-2009

- Planning and preparation of Tier 1 Framework in Cohort 1 schools

2009-2010

- Cohort 1: implementation of PBIS Tier 1

2010-2011

- Cohort 2: implementation of PBIS Tier 1
- Cohort 1: implementation of PBIS Tier 1 and Tier 2

2011-2012

- Cohort 3: implementation of PBIS Tier 1
- Cohort 1 and Cohort 2: implementation of PBIS Tier 1 and Tier 2

2012-2013

- Cohort 2 and Cohort 3: Implementation of PBIS Tier 1 and Tier 2
- Cohort 1: Implementation of PBIS Tier 1, Tier 2, and Tier 3
- November: Facilitators at seven high schools and district staff trained in RENEW conducted by University of New Hampshire- Office on Disability
- January: Initial trained facilitators began implementation of RENEW at their schools
- May: remaining high school facilitators trained in RENEW
- June: RENEW overview conducted for district administrators
- Creation of RENEW resources website on Milwaukee Public Schools website

2013-2014

- All schools: implementation of PBIS Tier 1, Tier 2, and Tier 3
- All facilitators trained in RENEW at every high school began implementation of RENEW with at least one student at the school
- PBIS District team added a school social worker and school psychologist to provide coaching support for all Tier 3 behavior interventions throughout the district
- Online coaching conference calls were held monthly with trainers from University of New Hampshire- Office on Disability
- January: RENEW training for recently hired high school staff members: school psychologists and school social workers
- Peer Support Circles model implemented to provide additional coaching support to RENEW facilitators throughout the district
- District Support Team trained to use RENEW Integrity Tool by WI PBIS Network- RENEW Implementation Tool (RIT) completed by 21 RENEW facilitators in schools

2014-2015

- Fall: RENEW training of newly hired school psychologists and school social workers
- Creation of RENEW First 30 Days checklist
- Creation of more in-depth progress monitoring of student-specific goals
- Continued use of Peer Support Circles
- Creation of MPS District Tier 3 Leadership Team
- District Support Team worked towards earning certification from New Hampshire Office on Disability to become RENEW certified coaches
- All schools completed “RENEW School Summary” of demographic, behavioral, and academic data of students participating in RENEW
- RENEW Facilitators completed the RENEW Integrity Tool
- District Support Team completed the RENEW Implementation Checklist for the district
