**Beaver Bucks**

Students who display exceptional behaviors will be acknowledged through **Beaver Bucks**. An adult can give this 2 part buck to a student as **recognition for positive behavior**. Once received, one (1) part will go into a weekly drawing. The student whose name is drawn by their team will be acknowledged on morning announcements.

The 2nd part can be accumulated and redeemed at the Beaver Bucks store. The Beaver Bucks Store will be open one (1) day a week and children will be able to exchange bucks for pencils, erasers, etc.



**Consequences for  
Negative Behavior**

All students start each morning with a clean slate on the Behavior Expectation Chart. If their behavior becomes problematic, their charts will be marked.

**Verbal Warning**

A reminder to check behavior

**Stop, Think Decide**

Take a break to rethink

**Time Out**

Rethink and record the incident

**Support Teacher**

Temporary removal from classroom

**Parent Notification**

Phone call to parent

**Administrative Involvement**

Student is sent to the office
